

TK50-R, TK50-D TAPE DRIVE

The TK50 subsystem is a tape drive enclosed in either a rackmount or free-standing housing. Each TK50-D or TK50-R subsystem has its own power supply and fan. The tape drive holds one removable magnetic tape cartridge.

- Each tape cartridge stores up to 94 million characters or about 34,800 typewritten pages.
- Information stored on a tape can be written or erased.

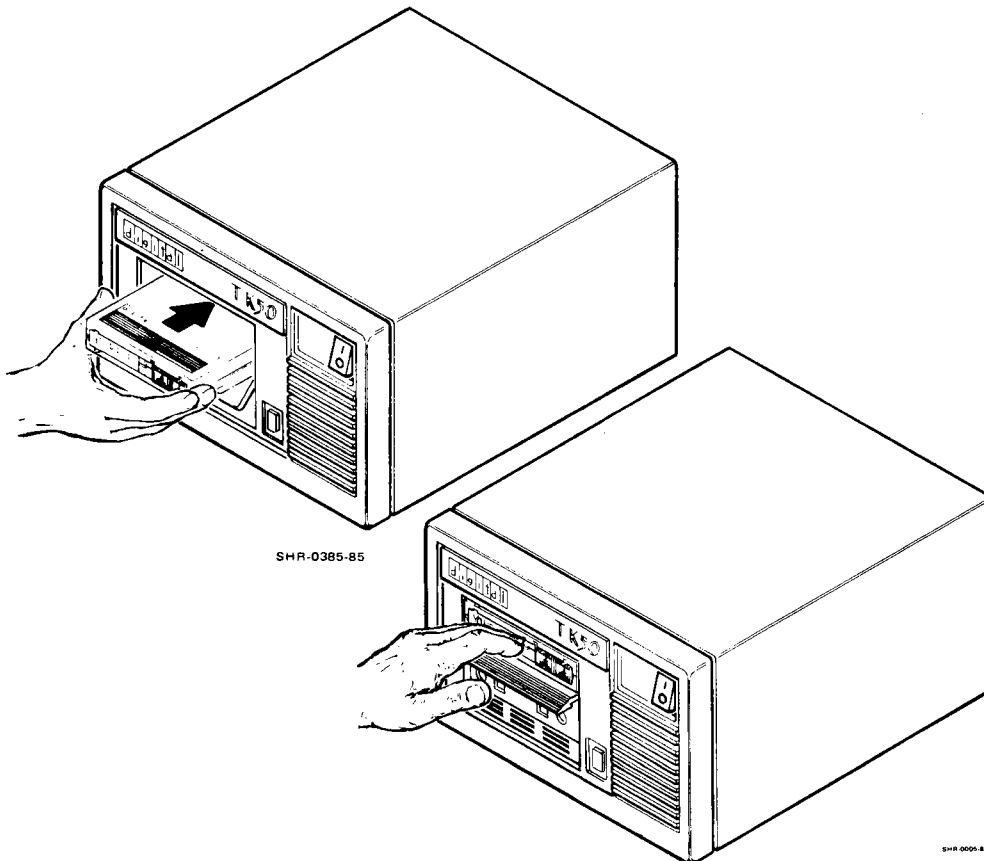


Figure 4-3 Inserting a Tape Cartridge

You must insert the tape cartridge correctly into the tape drive. Make sure the arrow on the tape cartridge faces up (Figure 4-3).
