

DEC STD 066-0 Digital Design Standards

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ABSTRACT: This standard lists the Digital design standards required for the design of Digital products.

APPLICABILITY: This standard is mandatory for all Digital personnel involved in designing or specifying the design of any Digital product worldwide. This includes products purchased for resale. Exceptions to these requirements are authorized only by a waiver in accordance with the requirements in DEC STD 066-2 Waivers to Digital Design Standards, unless otherwise stated in the design standard.

STATUS: Approved 21-Jul-1992; use VTX SMC for current status.

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1 INTRODUCTION

Digital develops, manufactures, sells, installs, and maintains products that meet the requirements of all Digital design standards.

Identification of applicable design standards and conformance to the requirements defined in those standards must be addressed for each product to be sold by Digital before that product exits Phase 1 of the phase review process. Refer to *DEC STD 028-0 Phase Review Policy*. It is recommended that the Product Manager or the Responsible Engineer for the product or both address this requirement as early as possible in Phase 1.

If the product plan for a Digital product does not include the intent to conform to the requirements defined in applicable standards during Phase 1, a waiver is required. Refer to *DEC STD 066-2 Waivers to Digital Design Standards*. An Engineering Change Order (ECO) or other design change that causes a deviation from the design requirements in applicable standards requires a waiver in accordance with DEC STD 066-2. A change in a design requirement in a standard that causes nonconformance of existing products shall be handled as specified in that standard.

1.1 PURPOSE

This standard lists the internal design standards that must be complied with in the design, development, and manufacture of products to be sold by Digital worldwide. It identifies the applicable design standards for Digital Service, Hardware Design, Manufacturing, Systems and Architecture, and Technical Information Management.

1.2 SCOPE

This standard applies to all products to be sold by Digital worldwide, and lists all mandatory Digital design standards.

Some Digital design standards adopt third-party standards by reference. Adherence to these adopted standards is required to the extent stated in the adopting Digital standard.

This standard does not list the process standards required for Engineering, Manufacturing, and other groups that have chosen to build or support products; such standards are not required for the design process.

NOTE

Digital standards are mandatory. This document focuses only on design-related standards. Refer to VTX SMC for a complete on-line directory of Digital standards and related documents, abstracts, and the responsible person and group.

2 DIGITAL DESIGN STANDARDS

Following is a numerical listing of *all* Digital standards governing the design process. These standards are mandatory when they apply; any intended deviation requires a waiver in accordance with the requirements of DEC STD 066-2 unless otherwise stated in specific standards.
